

**WOMAD Traders**  
**FAQ's 2026**

**GENERAL**

This year the festival will be held at a new site. The address is:

The site will be smaller than previous years which means we will be taking fewer traders than usual and will be more selective with which stalls we choose.

Although in previous years we have been able to guarantee certain pitches, this will not be possible this year due to the layout of the site. We are moving to a new location and so will not be able to guarantee certain neighbours/ areas. There will be two main catering strips, plus a late night area, as well as sections of the site for general merchandise and charities.

**FEES**

**How are fees calculated and can they be adjusted once an offer has been made?**

Your pitch fee is based on the number of tickets you have requested and the location of your stall. There are additional fees for power and water requirements. Please refer to the rules and regulations on the homepage of the WOMAD website for more information about fees and pricing.

**When do I need to make payment?**

Payment must be made in full for all pitches by 17/04/2026. All information regarding payments and due dates will be sent to you via email and will be available for you to view on event halo. Please ensure you check this regularly for updates. Here you can also view and download your invoices and see information about what you have already ordered e.g. number of tickets/ power and water requirements etc.

**If I am unable to attend the festival, will my fee be refunded?**

No, unfortunately fees cannot be refunded for any reason.

**TICKETS**

**When will I receive my tickets?**

Tickets will be sent to you via email at the beginning of July. They will contain a barcode that will need to be scanned, and exchanged for a wristband at the Traders Office when you arrive on site. Lost wristbands will not be replaced.

### **Can I buy more tickets if I have been made an offer?**

Yes you can. Reduced rate adult and child tickets will be made available and can be booked once you have accepted your offer. More details will be sent out regarding pricing closer to the event.

### **Are tickets/ wristbands transferable for staff?**

No. Each person coming to site needs to have their own ticket/ wristband, even if they are only on site for one day. Anyone coming to site just for build/ break will be permitted entry up to 20:00 on Wednesday evening when the traders office closes.

### **What car passes can I have?**

Your vehicle passes will be issued from the Traders Office when you arrive on site. The types of passes are shown below. Make sure you select the correct passes in your application.

<b>Type</b>	<b>Details</b>
On Site	This pass allows your vehicle access onto site and parking behind your pitch.
Staff Car Park	This pass allows you to access your pitch to drop off and then park in the Staff Car Park. <b>Parking is not permitted behind your stand.</b>
Delivery	This pass is for any vehicles that are delivering to site and will not be staying. It allows access to pitches and is only valid on the day of issue.

## **PITCHES**

### **Can WOMAD provide tents or any other infrastructure for our stall?**

Unfortunately we are not able to book any tents/ infrastructure for you. You must provide everything you need for your pitch. If you hire a tent and it needs to be erected before you arrive, arrangements can be made through the traders office by emailing [traders@womad.com](mailto:traders@womad.com).

### **When will I get the location of my pitch?**

The location of your pitch will be given to you on arrival. We will do our best to fulfil any special requests, however this is the first year on a new site so do expect changes from 2024.

### **Can I bring a sound system to WOMAD?**

No, sound systems are not allowed on site unless permission has been given by the traders office in advance.

### **Can I camp behind my pitch?**

Yes, all the market areas have camping available behind your stall.

## What has happened to the arboretum and therapists?

Although we do not have the arboretum in 2026, we are looking for 4-5 standalone treatments (not including massage) to be part of our new Wellness Village. This is an exciting new area where you will work with the festival to provide treatments. ## **TRADING**

### What are the trading hours at WOMAD?

The opening times of each area of the site are shown below. In all areas we would expect traders to be open between 10:00 - 22:00 but longer if you wish/ depending on the type of trade e.g. breakfast/ late night.

Your offer letter will state which area you will be trading in.

Artisan Tent (within the Main Arena)	<b>Thursday</b> 14:00 - 22:00 <b>Friday</b> 10:00 - 22:00 <b>Saturday</b> 10:00 - 22:00 <b>Sunday</b> 10:00 - 22:00
Campsite	Opens 08:00 Thursday then open 24 hours until 11:00 on Monday

### Is there anything I can't sell?

Please list all goods/ food you will be selling and refer to the Rules and Regulations for the list of banned items.

### Can we have deliveries to our stall during the festival?

A list of preferred wholesales will be sent to all food traders nearer the time. Other deliveries will be permitted onto site but at restricted times. Deliveries can be collected on foot from the Traders Office during the show.
